The international scientific conference "Theoretical and Applied Ethics: Traditions and Prospects" is devoted to the study of the most important ethical phenomena of modern society and the categories of morality and practical philosophy. The key task of the conference this year is to identify the theoretical and methodological foundations of the current state of ethical science, to identify the main problems and prospects for the development of scientific research in the field of theoretical and applied ethics. History has repeatedly confronted humans with the limit situations, as well as today's world issues new challenges for us. Thus, the value strategies, the choice that everyone makes in such conditions should be the direct subject of ethical research. The practice of philosophical understanding of economic, political and civil shocks in Russia has formed the tradition of ethical and philosophical reflection in the context of the transformation of reality.

The tradition of holding international ethical conferences at St. Petersburg State University (Institute of Philosophy) dates back to 2007. The geography of our participants over the past 5 years only: Moscow, St. Petersburg, Novosibirsk, Krasnoyarsk, Murmansk, Kostroma, Kaliningrad, Voronezh, Saratov, Makhachkala, Yakutsk, Omsk, Yekaterinburg, Volgograd, Tyumen, Ryazan, Tambov, Perm, Omsk, etc. The range of foreign participants is wide: Lithuania, Finland, Spain, USA, Argentina, Brazil, Germany, Italy, France, Belarus, Poland, Slovakia, Japan, Iran, Kuwait. The conference is attended by young scientists, which contributes to their involvement in scientific life.

The conference is held both in person and online.
